The Governor received a communication from the Senate informing him of their advice and consent to the appointments severally of Civil Officers for Charles County, except the Chief Judge of the Orphans Court, of the Civil Officers for Kent County, except the Chief Judge of the Orphans Court, and of certain persons to be Justices of the peace for Talbot County, agreeably to the nominations of the 25th of February last.

Gentlemen:— Having ascertained very recently that several of the persons, who were heretofore nominated by me to your Honorable Body, for Justices of the peace and Coroners for Queen Anne's County have died, or removed out of the County, I respectfully ask permission to withdraw the list of nominations for Justices of the peace and Coroners, for said County, in order that it may be revised and corrected.
