The Governor this day issued the following Proclamation:

State of Maryland to wit:

Whereas, it has been the practice of all Christian People to set apart days for Public Thanksgiving and Prayer, as a National testimony to the goodness and Mercy of Divine Providence; - and whereas, it is the especial duty of those, who have enjoyed his largest bounty, to manifest their gratitude and sense of dependence; - And Whereas, the People of this State have been in a most signal manner, enriched with every temporal
