Enoch Louis Lowe, Governor of the State of Maryland,
To His Excellency, the Governor of Pennsylvania:

It appears by the annexed papers, duly authenticated, according to the laws of this State, that a certain Dutch Law, alias Lewis Baldwin, alias Lewis M. Ream, stands charged upon the oath of John Graham with feloniously passing on a certain John Frederick, a certain false, forged and counterfeited note, purporting to be a genuine note for the payment of twenty dollars of a Bank regularly constituted by the laws of this State, to wit, the Bank of Baltimore, with the intention to defraud the said John Frederick, against the Act of Assembly of this State in such case made and provided, and it has been represented to me that he hath fled from the justice of this State and hath taken refuge within the state of Pennsylvania:

Now therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Law of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Dutch Law, alias Lewis Baldwin, alias Lewis M. Ream be apprehended and delivered to John Graham, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the state of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.
