The Governor approved the Bond of James W. Hunter, Acting Public in Anne Arundel County.

31st.

The Governor issued his warrant to the Sheriff of any County in this State for the Delivery of a certain Joshua Red charged with burglary to G. H. Hale Esq. agent of Pennsylvania.

September 3<sup>d</sup>.

The Governor directed notice of application for Writ of Habeas Corpus in favor of Thomas C. Worrell indicted in Talbot County for assault and battery, to be published, to expire the 28th. inst.

5th.

The Governor directed notice of application for Writ of Habeas Corpus in favor of Elisha Lee, negro, charged in Baltimore City with Larceny to be published, to expire 27th. instant.

12th.

The Governor remitted a fine of Fifty dollars imposed on James Whittington, free negro, in Anne Arundel County, for selling liquor without license upon the recommendation of Judge Proctor.

13th.

The Governor directed notice of application for Writ of Habeas Corpus in favor of Isaac and Truman, slaves of Mr. Mary Hall of Frederick County, charged with Larceny.

14th.

The Governor received the resignation of John H. Franklin, Esquire, as Commissioner of Public Works for Fourth District to take Effect the 1st. of October.

17th.

The Governor issued a proclamation offering a reward of one hundred dollars for the apprehension of Walter Watkins Jr., a fugitive, charged with an attempt to commit suicide, in Anne Arundel County.

The Governor remitted a fine of twenty dollars imposed on George Key, for the violation of the laws relating to public worship. Cecil County.
