December 6th.

The Governor directed notice of application for pardon of Dennis Shenton, convicted of murder in second degree in Dorchester County Court at October Term 1849, to be published; to expire December 26th. instant.

The Governor approved the bond of Lemuel Roberts Esq. - 'elected' Commissioner of Lotteries.

8th.

The Governor issued a commission to Samuel Chamberlaine Esq. as Commissioner of Public Works, vice himself elected thereto, and failed to qualify, within the time prescribed by law.

The Governor directed notice of application for pardon of James Ayde, negro, convicted at January Term 1851, of Baltimore City Court, of larceny, to be published; to expire on the 19th. instant.

The Governor offered a reward of two hundred dollars for the apprehension of Octavius M. Lyle, a fugitive, charged with the crime of murder, committed in Anne Arundel County.

14th.

The Governor issued the following Requisition:
State of Maryland, To Wit:

Ernest Louis Lowe, Governor of the State of Maryland,
To His Excellency, the Governor of Virginia.

It appears by the annexed papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of the State, that a certain Octavius M. Pherson Lyle stands charged upon the oath of Philip S. Smith, duly made, with having stabbed and murdered a certain Thomas M. Garner, on the night of the seventh of December instant, at a place called the "Cove" in Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland, and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of Virginia:

Now, therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States, in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Octavius M. Pherson Lyle be apprehended and delivered to John Lamb, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland to be dealt with according to law.
