This day this day transmitted to the House of Delegates a Letter from the Commissioner of the Land Office respecting the State of Records and papers in that office

In pursuance of an Act of the recent General Assembly delivered to Geo. S. Beaver Agent for Henry M. Fitzhugh the following original letters from W^m Fitzhugh viz^t one of date Nov 1 - 1780, one Nov 13 - 1780 and one of July 17 - 1783 - all on the subject of his services in the War of the Revolution.

11th

This day the Governor appointed and issued Commissions to Richard N. Miles, Isaac M. Deinson, James M. Schley, Milton M. Kidd, William M. Starr, John Carroll Hales, John Stewart and John B. Brook as Aid-de-camps to his Excellency

The Gov received a Notice from Chas J. M. Quinn Esq that he accepted the appointment as State Counsel in the case of Manly vs State of Maryland in Court of Appeals.

This day the Gov issued his warrant to the Sheriff of Baltimore City or any County authorizing him to arrest and deliver Hugh Sloan alias James Sloan, to Lewis Keffington Esq Agent of the State of Pennsylvania under a Requisition. Said Sloan being a fugitive from Justice charged with Riot and engaging in a Prize fight.
