Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland That the Governor be, and he is hereby ~~authorized~~ requested to issue a commission in the usual form to the Hon. James B. Pearce as Senator to represent this State in the Congress of the United States for six years from the fourth of March Eighteen hundred and fifty five.

He hereby certifies the foregoing to be a true copy of the Original Resolution which passed the Genl Assembly of Maryland at its January session 1854.
