The Governor refused a Pardon in the case of John H. Tydings convicted of Larceny at the April Term 1853 of Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County.

A communication from H. W. W. Davis Esq. Atty at Law, accepting his appointment as Counsel on the part of the State in the case of the State vs Benjamin J. Gardner in Circuit Court for Prince Georges County, was received this day.

The Governor this day issued a Requisition in the usual form upon the Governor of the State of Virginia for the apprehension of Jacob Gore and Thomas Kernan, charged by indictment in the Circuit Court for Washington County with Larceny and their delivery to William Logan Agent of this State to receive them.
