

The Governor this day reconsidered his refusal of a Pardon in the case of John H. Tydings convicted of Larceny at the April Term 1853 of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County and directed the publication of the usual Notice to be made in the case.

11th

The Governor this day signed the Hon. John Nelson, of Baltimore, City, as Counsel on the part of the State in State vs. Syles, under indictment for murder, to be tried at the approaching term of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County, if which Court they said range has been removed from the Circuit Court for Baltimore City.

12th

The Governor this day issued his Proclamation offering a Reward of \$200 for the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who may have been concerned in the perpetration of a most atrocious murder committed upon the body of one Sarah Jane Eves on the night of 27th March 1854 near Liberty in Frederick County.

14th

The Governor this day remitted two fines, of fifty dollars each, imposed upon Elizabeth Bevell at the March Term 1854 of the Circuit Court for Howard County for selling spirituous liquors contrary to law.
