

May 31<sup>st</sup> 1854.

The Governor this day granted a pardon to Samuel Howard convicted of larceny at the March Term of Washington County Court and sentenced to confinement in the Penitentiary till May 9<sup>th</sup> 1856.

June 1<sup>st</sup> 1854.

The Gov. this day remitted the fine of \$20. imposed May 20<sup>th</sup> 1854 by Leshua Pundum Esq a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County for trading and peddling with the Licence of another, ~~imposed~~ Samuel Brown.

The Governor this day issued, upon the Requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania, to the Sheriff of Baltimore City, his Warrant for the arrest and delivery to John Scott Esq, the Agent of the State of Pennsylvania in that behalf, of a certain George Higgins charged with horse stealing and being a fugitive from the Justice of said State.

June 3<sup>rd</sup> 1854.

The Governor issued a certificate under Act of 1854. ch. 224 certifying to the Comptroller that he is satisfied that the sum of five thousand dollars has been paid from private contributions to the Treasurer of the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the Blind.

June 7<sup>th</sup> 1854.

The Governor directed the usual notice of the application having been made for the pardon of John Murray, convicted at June Term 1844 of the late Baltimore City Court of Burglary of Robbery and sentenced to serve and labor in the Penitentiary for the term of seven and five years
