

June 8th 1854.

The Governor this day issued his Proclamation offering a Reward of ~~Two~~ hundred dollars for the arrest of a certain John T. Bailey charged with the murder of a certain Philip Jenkins on or about the 25th day of December 1852 in Charles County. Sent to Baltimore Daily Sun and Republican and Argus for publication 3 times.

June 14th 1854.

The Governor this day directed the usual publication of Notice of application having been made for the pardon of John Jones convicted at Jan. Term 1854 of the Criminal Court for Baltimore City of an assault on one Lavett Prior, and sentenced to be imprisoned six months in Baltimore City and County and to pay a fine of \$20. and costs.

The Governor this day issued a Requisition upon the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania for the apprehension of John Thompson charged by the oath of John T. Sinner with the larceny of a horse and wagon the property of said John T. and Edward Sinner. Delivery of the fugitive directed to ~~be~~ made to the said John T. Sinner.

June 30th 1854.

The Governor this day directed publication of the usual Notice in the matter of the application for the Pardon of John Hollett convicted of Manslaughter at May Term 1854 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore.
