

August 9<sup>th</sup> 1854.

The Governor this day issued his Proclamation offering a Reward of Two hundred dollars for the arrest of Benedict Street charged with the murder of one James M. Shane on the night of the 1<sup>st</sup> August inst. at Principio Furnace in Cecil County.

August 17<sup>th</sup> 1854

The Gov issued this day a Requisition upon the Governor of North Carolina for the apprehension of a certain Thomas Banks charged upon the oath of Lacey & Manahan of the firm of Mercer & Manahan with having obtained goods and merchandise by false and fraudulent representations and pretences with intent to defraud and cheat said Mercer & Manahan, and his delivery to John Kichan Agent of the State of Maryland in that behalf.

September 5<sup>th</sup> 1854.

The Gov. this day directed publication of the usual Notice of Application of having been made for a North Prosecution in the case of Andrew Boyd and James Sulland confined in the Jail of Cecil County on a charge of Larceny.

September 19<sup>th</sup> 1854.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Richard Libby of Baltimore City Ad-jut. Camp to his Excellency with the Rank of Colonel.
