

November 11<sup>th</sup> 1854.

The Governor this day issued his requisition, directed to the Chief Justice of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Columbia, for the apprehension and delivery to Anderson J. Richardson, Agent for the State of Maryland in that behalf, of Christian Slutz and Charles Henry Slutz, indicted in the Circuit Court for Prince Georges County, the said Christian for an assault and the said Charles Henry for an assault with intent to kill upon a certain Edward H. Duvall, the said Charles Henry and Christian Slutz being fugitives from Justice and alleged to have taken refuge within the District of Columbia.

November 14<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day issued his Requisition upon the Governor of the State of North Carolina requesting that a certain Adolph Scher, charged upon the oath of John B. Cherron of the firm of Bartholomew Tiffany and Co. of the City of Baltimore with obtaining goods from the said firm under false pretences, be apprehended and delivered to Benjamin J. Bartholomew, the States Agent in that behalf.

November 15<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day remitted forfeitures in the case of the state vs Nathaniel M. Soper and Dr. J. Laroc upon recognizance entered into by them in the sum of fifty dollars each for the appearance of Peter Lusby before the Circuit Court for Prince Georges County at the April Term 1854 of said Court.
