The Governor remitted on payment of costs, the forfeiture of the Recognizance of John Barran entered into in the sum of fifty dollars at the May Term 1854 of the Circuit Court for Calvert County for the appearance of Negro John Curtis.

The Governor this day upon the requisition of the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania issued his warrant, directed to any Sheriff of this State, for the arrest and delivery to the Prisoner, the Agent of the said Commonwealth in that behalf, of a certain David Delaney charged by Indictment with the crime of Seduction and Abduction and Bastardy in Franklin County in said Commonwealth.

The Governor refused to pardon Rufus S. Beard, convicted Oct. Term 1854. of the Circuit Court for Prince Georges County of an Assault and Battery on one Thomas Smyth.

Proclamations this day made by the Governor offering a reward of Two Hundred dollars for the apprehension of a certain Valentine Kilbinger charged with the murder of one Jacob Lee in Harford County on or about 2<sup>d</sup> April inst.
