

June 28th 1855

The Governor this day forwarded, per Howland and Aspinwall of the City of New York, authentic copies of Resolutions No. 9 of the January session of the Legislature 1854 to the following gentlemen, viz. Captain Storffer of the Antartic; Captain Lane of the Kirby; Captain Brighton of the Barge Three Bells and Captain James J. Matthews late commander of the San Francisco.

The Gov also took charge of an copy of same for delivery to some of the family of Frank Hay Murray of the United States Army.

The Governor directed publication of the usual notice of application having been made to him for the pardon of Elizabeth Blackburnett alias Elizabeth Smith convicted May Term ¹⁸⁵⁵ of the Criminal Court of Baltimore of larceny. To be considered on or after July 23^d 1855.

July 2^d

The Gov. this day issued an order to the Adjutant General of the State directing him to have on the 4th inst. the National flag displayed from the steeple of the State House and the usual salutes fired in commemoration of the Anniversary of American Independence.

July 14th

The Governor this day remitted two several fines imposed upon John Burdett by Montgomery Circuit Court at its November Term 1854 as follows viz. one of \$20. for retaining liquor contrary to law and one of \$50 for keeping a disorderly house.
