

The Requisition upon the Governor of the State of Massachusetts issued July 26th 1855 for George Bonner alias Henry Best, alias Charles Bellum was this day returned to this Department unexecuted. The fugitive having come into this State in custody.

The Requisition which issued 16th July 1855 upon the Governor of Pennsylvania for George W. Lane was also returned this day for some reason, unexecuted.

Aug^t 18th

The Governor this day approved the bond of John A. Keller, Notary Public for Frederick Allegany County.

The Gov. this day remitted a fine of \$50. imposed upon David N. Newcomer by the Circuit Court for Washington County at its July Term 1855 for selling one gallon of whiskey without license.

Aug^t 20th

The Gov. directed publication of Notice of application having been made to him for a Writ of Habeas Corpus in the case of John Most indicted by the Circuit Court for Allegany County for forging Notice sent to Allegany, Cumberland. Case to be considered 10th Sep. next.

Aug^t 28th

The Governor this pardoned John Martin for forgery who was convicted at May Term 1855 of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County of Maryland and sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years.
