

April 18<sup>th</sup> 1856.

The Governor this day received and approved the Official Bond of J. H. Etchison, Tobacco Inspector at Warehouse No 4 in the City of Baltimore.

Same day the Governor remitted the Fine of \$100. imposed upon James Rawlings, at the November Term 1854 of the Circuit Court for Montgomery County, for an Assault and Battery.

Same day the Governor received, per hand of Chapman Harwood, Secretary of the Senate of Maryland, a certified copy of the following Resolution of the General Assembly to wit: "Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby requested to issue a Commission in the usual form to the Hon. Anthony Kennedy as Senator to represent this State in the Congress of the United States for six years from the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 1857."

Whereupon a Commission was forthwith issued as requested.

The Governor this day received and approved the Bond of George H. Bennett State Wharfinger.

23<sup>d</sup>

The Governor this day granted a Pardon to John H. Williams, convicted Sept. Term 1849 of the late Baltimore City Court of Murder in the Second Degree. See Record of Pardons.

Same day the Governor remitted the fine of \$10 which was imposed upon Samuel G. Smith by the Circuit Court for Caroline County at March Term 1856 for "selling horse feed without license."
