The Governor this day approved the Official Bond of George A. Searman Mayor Public Baltimore City.

Same day the Governor remitted a fine of \$33.33³/₄ imposed upon Moses Johnson, convicted April Term 1856 of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County of purchasing of Robert Lamberts share of Judge Peters Case &c.

8th

This day the Governor remitted a Fine of \$5- which was imposed upon James Anderson at the February Term 1856 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County for Assault &c.

Hughes, who stands, charged by the oath of James B. McArthur, with having on or about the 20th day of April 1856 with having stolen taken and carried away from Gold Patent Lower Watch of the value of \$45 the property of the said James B. McArthur.
