

Same day the Governor granted a Pardon to Lewis Kelly, free Negro, who was convicted at the April Term 1856 of the Circuit Court for the County of Lancaster. See Record of Pardons.

27th

The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued to the Sheriff of Baltimore City, or Sheriff of any County, his warrant for the arrest and delivery to Benjamin F. King, the Agent of that State in that behalf, of Joseph Friedlander alias Wischberg a Fugitive from justice charged with the crime of Larceny.

30th

The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued his Warrant, directed to any Sheriff of this State, for the arrest and delivery to Daniel Hinrichs, Agent of the State of Pennsylvania in that behalf, of a certain John Neegy, a Fugitive from Justice charged with the crime of Fornication and Bastardy.

June 3rd

The Governor directed publication of Notice of application having been made to him for the pardon of Charles Gottle who was convicted at the April Term 1856 of the Circuit Court Anne Arundel County of Assault and Battery and sentenced to be confined in the County jail for the term of three months. Case to be considered on or after the 16th inst.

4th

The Gov. upon the Requisition of the Gov. of Pennsylvania issued his Warrant, directed to any Sheriff, for the arrest and delivery to the Sheriff the Agent of Pennsylvania in that behalf, of a person known as "Frederick" a fugitive from justice charged with stealing a Fur and Game Bag.
