23<sup>rd</sup>

The Governor this day issued his Requisition upon the Governor of the State of Missouri for the arrest and delivery to agent of this State in that State, of a certain Louis Richard, alias C. Brannin, alias George Conner, alias Henry Best, alias Alexander Gray, alias J. Lambert, alias Motine Dutton, alias Arthur De Grange, alias Edward Martin, alias Charles Bel, alias Joseph Diet a fugitive from Justice charged upon the oath of Henry Robert Tucker with the crime of Burglary and Counterfeiting.

29<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day remanded James Martin who was convicted January Term 1851 of the late Baltimore City Court of robbing A. B. Mosher and sentenced to serve and labor in the Penitentiary for the term of seven years.

Nov. 5<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day issued his Requisition upon the Governor of New Jersey for the arrest and delivery to Stephen A. Mundy, agent, of the said John, John, Isaac Morris and Henry Morris, in the matter of charge set forth in entry of Jan 11<sup>th</sup>
