The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued his Warrant directed to any Sheriff in this State for the arrest and delivery to James Haysman, Agent of the State of Pennsylvania on that behalf, of a certain James C. Forbes a fugitive from Justice charged upon Indictment with the Crime of Treason.

13<sup>th</sup>

The Governor directed publication of notice of application having been made to him for the return of John Smith Fulford indicted at the Circuit Term 1856 of Maryland. Case to be considered on or after Dec. 1-1856.

Since day the Governor directed publication of notice of application having been made to him for a writ Habeas Corpus in the matter of the writ of James H. Finley indicted in the Circuit Court for Washington County for an Assault and Battery. To be considered on or after Dec. 1-1856.
