Hillier and Jacob Cook, Agents of this State in that
County of Edward Hammond alias Edward
Hammond and George B. Ward, alias Foot Wilkins, charged
by indictment in the Criminal Court of Baltimore with
the Larceny of Three hundred Gold Chains of the
value of five dollars each, twenty gold Rings
each of the value of one dollar and twelve gold
Bracelets each of the value of thirteen dollars.

The Governor this day signed Nelson's
Exp. Counsel on the part of the State in the
matter of the Extra Dividend by the Board of
Directors in the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road
Company, in aid of Hon. Geo. Nelson's petition.

9th

The Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi
in the case of the State vs Thomas Springer
indicted in the Circuit Court for Frederick County
for having on the 21st day of April 1853 feloniously
taken and carried away certain pieces of
Silver Ware the goods and property of one Jacob
Munkel. The said Thomas Springer to pay the costs
accrued upon said Indictment.

Same day the Governor directed Notice
to be given of Application having been made
to him for a Nolle Prosequi in State vs Peter
Bostick for negro, charged upon the oath of J. J.
R. Pool and Charles W. Binney with having
left the State of Maryland and returned there
contrary to statute. To be considered for or after
Monday 23rd inst.

10th

The Gov. this day granted a Pardon to Joseph
Simsot, convicted Nov. Term 1852 of Circuit Court for
Baltimore Co. of carrying a slave to run away. See Public Record.
