

Same day the Governor issued his Requisition upon the Governor of the Territory of Minnesota for the arrest and delivery, to Joseph A. Chubbie, Agent in that behalf, of one Lyons L. Snyder, charged upon the oath of one Johnathon D. Seymour with having by means of certain false and fraudulent pretences obtained from the said Johnathon D. Seymour certain valuable goods and chattels to wit two hundred paper bound books of the value of ten cents each.

Same day the Governor remitted three several fines of \$20 each imposed upon Edward Lushy by the Circuit Court for Prince Georges County at its April Term 1856 for selling spirituous Liqueur on the Sabbath.

18th

The Governor this day directed publication of Notice that application has been made to him for the pardon of Zachariah Shaw, convicted February Term 1855 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County of persuading certain Negro Slaves to abscond. To be considered on or after Monday March 16. 1857.

21st

The Governor this day issued the following Order.

John Wilson Adj't. Gen. M. M.

Sir. You are hereby directed to have, on Monday the 23rd inst. [the 22nd falling on Sunday] the National Flag displayed from the State House Steeple, a Federal salute fired at sunrise a National Salute at noon and a Federal salute at sunset in commemoration of the birth day of George Washington.
