

July 21st 1857.

The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of the State of California, issued his Warrant directed to the Sheriff of Montgomery County or any other County of this State, for the arrest and delivery of A. G. M. Brown, Agent of the State of California in that behalf, of one Samuel Strong charged with the crime of obtaining money under false pretences. See Papers & Files.

24th

The Gov. this day granted a *Nolle Prosequi* in State vs. Peter Braddock, Free Negro, charged with having left the State and returned thence contrary to Law. See Record.

Same day the Governor granted a Pardon to James H. Jenkins, convicted November Term 1856 of the Circuit Court for Talbot County of Larceny. See Record of Pardons

24th

The Governor this day directed publication of Notice of Application having been made to him for the Pardon of Samuel Howard, indicted Nov Term 1856 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore of Manslaughter. To be considered on or after Thursday March 19th 1857.

Same day the Governor directed Notice to be given that Applications had been made to him for a *Nolle Prosequi* in the matter of the State vs. Antonio Antonio indicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore for an Assault with intent to kill. To be considered on or after Saturday March 21-1857.
