

March 1st 1854

The Governor this day directed publication of Notice that Application has been made to him for the Pardon of Edward Leatherberry, convicted Sep. Term 1851 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore of Larceny. To be considered on or after Monday March 23^d 1854.

Mar. 1st

The Governor this day issued his Requisition upon the Governor of Pennsylvania for the arrest and delivery to J. Leeds Barroll, or some agent appointed by him, of a certain Joseph White alias William Brown charged upon the affidavit with the crime of Horse Stealing.

March 14th

The Governor this day remitted a Fine of \$50. imposed upon one Margaret Murphy at the March Term 1854 of the Circuit Court for Washington County for selling liquor without license.

March 15th

The Gov. this day granted a Pardon to Zachariah Shaw, convicted at the February Term 1855 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County of persuading slaves to run away. See Record of Pardons.

March 17th

The Governor this issued his Requisition upon the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Columbia for the arrest and delivery to William Sawyer, Agent of this State in that behalf, of a certain Asa Ricketts, charged by Indictment in the Criminal Court of Baltimore at the January Term 1854 with having obtained, by means of certain false pretences, of James Madley, Henry B. Madley and William G. Kellinger, divers goods, wares and
