

April 1. 1857

The Governor this day committed a fine of fifty dollars imposed upon one James Beazy in the Circuit Court for Washington County for selling liquor without license.

April 3^d.

The Governor this day found his Requisition upon the Honorable the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Columbia for the arrest and delivery to Daniel H. Ayer, Agent in that behalf, of William Smith Senior, William Smith Junior and Robert Dean, severally charged by Indictments in the Circuit Court for Prince Georges County - Nov. Term 1856, with an obstruction of the due execution of the laws of the State by unlawfully using and practicing force and violence with intent to hinder, interrupt and prevent the election being held on the fourth day of November last past for Electors of President and Vice President of the United States in violation of the due exercise of the elective franchise.

April 8th

The Governor this day his Requisition upon the Honorable the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Columbia for the arrest and delivery to Peter P. Pote, Agent in that behalf, of a certain Wm. Barnock, a fugitive from Justice charged upon the affidavit of Thomas McBarne with having by means of a certain false pretence obtained from a certain Thomas C. Rich certain goods and chattels the property of the said Rich, with intent to steal and defraud the said Rich.

To be executed without cost to State unless the party charged shall be tried and convicted.

April 9th

The Hon. your Notice of Application having been made for the Prison of Michael O'Seal, committed March Term 1857 of Circuit Court for Howard County of Appa^lta to be considered on or after Friday May 1st 1857.
