

May 12th 1854.

The Hon. the Judge gave notice of Application having been made to him for a Note Prosequi in the case of the State versus Hyder Mitchell indicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore for Murder.

Also gave notice of Application having been made for the pardon of Hyder Mitchell committed in the Circuit Court for Baltimore County at the November Term 1856 of an Assault upon a certain William Sprunk and sentenced to one years imprisonment from Dec. 12th 1856 & to pay a fine of fifty dollars and costs. Both cases to be considered on or after 1st day of June 1857.

17th

The Hon. the Judge gave notice of Application having been made to him for the conditional pardon of Elijah Wilson, Henry Marks and Thomas Isaacs, Negro Slaves, committed at the May Term 1857 of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County on the several indictments for "beating the meat house at the Alms House and violating the same laws." To be considered on or after June 3rd 1857.

May 25th

The Hon. the Judge committed a fine of \$50 imposed in the case of the State versus John E. Egan by the Circuit Court for Allegany County at the April Term 1857 thereof for "selling liquor without license to minors."

May 26

The Hon. the Judge refused to grant a Note Prosequi in the case of the State versus John Bond indicted in the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County at March Term thereof 1857 for larceny.
