

Same day the Governor upon three several Requisitions of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued his three several Warrants, directed to my Sheriff of this State for the arrest and delivery to Daniel M. Hoffman, agent of the State of Pennsylvania in that behalf, of James Ober, William Elder and Michael Moore, severally charged by Indictment in York County Pa. with the crime of Fornication and Bawdery committed in said County.

May 29th 1857

The Governor this day remitted a fine of \$25. imposed upon Andrew Champion by Samuel M. Lander Esq. a Justice of the Peace of the State in and for Baltimore City on the 7th day of January 1857 for selling goods without license.

June 2nd 1857

The Governor this day granted a pardon to Henry Mitchell presented by the Grand Jury of Baltimore City and (on removal of the record) convicted in the Circuit Court of Baltimore County at its November Term 1856 of an Assault upon John Smith. See Record of Pardons

The same day the Governor granted a Wole Purgon to Hyde Mitchell indicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore at its September Term 1856 for Murder See Record of Pardons.

June 4th 1857

The Governor this day authorized notice to be given in the Maryland Republican of application in a Wole Purgon in the case of Owen David (Clare of James Owens) confined in the jail of Anne Arundel upon the charge of stealing a horse upon condition that the said David be sold and taken out of the State of Maryland and then return here. To be considered on or after the 18th June 1857

June 5th

The Governor this day directed notice to be given in the Alleganian of application for the pardon of Graham Brown alias Abraham Cooper, convicted of Larceny in the Circuit Court for Allegany County at its April Term 1857. To be considered on or after the 20th June 1857
