The Governor has day approved the Bond of Nathaniel Mc Brady as Notary Public at Williamsport, Washington Co. Md.

June 22nd 1857

The Governor this day directed notice to be given in the "Sun" and "Republican" that application had been made to him for the pardon of James P. Nelson convicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore at its Spring Term 1857 of an assault upon David Keefe. Notice is given July 1st 1857.

June 26th

The Governor this day granted a pardon to George H. Williams convicted in the Circuit Court for Charles County at its Summer Term 1857 of Larceny. See Record of Pardons.

June 29th

The Governor this day directed notice to be given in the "Sun" & "Republican" that application had been made to him for the pardon of Henry Neighorst convicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore at its September Term 1857 of Murder in the second degree.

He also directed notice to be given in the same papers that application had been made to him for the pardon of Samuel West convicted in the Criminal Court of Worcester at its Spring Term 1857 of Larceny. Notices in said cases to expire July 2nd 1857.

On Monday the Governor issued his Warrant upon the requisition of the Governor of Virginia, to any Sheriff in the State of Maryland, for the arrest and delivery to G. W. McHenry, Agent of said State of Virginia, of a certain Arthur Kaufman charged with the crime of horse stealing in said State of Virginia.
