

July 21-1857.

The Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi in the matter of the State vs. Richard Tydings indicted October Term 1854 of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County for an Assault with intent to commit a rape. See Record.

Same day the Governor granted a Nolle Prosequi to Walter J. Matthews, indicted as above in the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County for an Assault with attempt to commit a rape. See Record.

July 28<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day directed publication of Notice of application having been made to him for the pardon of John Reins convicted March Term 1857 of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County of an Assault with intent to kill. To be considered on or after Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1857.

Same day the Governor directed Notice to be given of application having been made to him for a Nolle Prosequi in case of State vs. William Knight and William D. Lippson indicted at the September Term 1856 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore for the murder of George W. Andrews. To be considered on or after Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1857.

Same day the Governor Refused a Pardon to James P. Nelson, convicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore of an Assault and adjudged to pay a fine of \$1.000 & to be imprisoned until the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1858.

August 10<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day gave Notice of application having been made to him for the Pardon of Geo. Washington convicted May Term 1857 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore, of carnally knowing and abusing
