

September 15<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day granted a *Nolle Prosequi* to H. Breenbink indicted in the Circuit Court for Howard County at March Term 1857 for obtaining goods under false pretences and for conspiracy to defraud R. W. Ware

September 21<sup>st</sup> 1857

The Governor this day issued a Requisition upon the Governor of Virginia for the arrest and delivery to Benjamin A. Gurlinger the agent of this State of a certain George W. Mc Lelland charged upon affidavit of feloniously stealing from the store house of Isaac Oppenheimer and Abram Koshland a quantity of merchandise particularly named in said affidavit.

September 22<sup>d</sup>

The Governor this day directed notice to be given of application having been made to him for the pardon of Parker Moore convicted in the Circuit Court for Harford County at its May Term 1857 of an assault and battery

To be considered on or after Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of October 1857.

In the matter of the State vs John Bowen and George Banks convicted at May Term 1857 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore for wilfully setting fire to a building in the yard of the Maryland Penitentiary, and in the matter of the State vs Theodore Bauman convicted at the same Term of carnally knowing and abusing the person of Louisa Reimig a female of the age of five years, The Governor this day commuted the punishment from death to confinement in the Penitentiary for life

September 25<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of New Jersey issued his warrant directed to the Sheriff of Baltimore County for the delivery to Arthur W. Vandevere agent of the State of New Jersey in that behalf of a certain Augustus Van Belt a fugitive from justice charged with the crime of stealing a horse wagon and harness.
