To the Sheriff of Worcester County, Greeting,

Whereas Helleny R Pitts a Senator
of the State of Maryland for Worcester County has communicated
in writing to the Governor his resignation as Senator aforesaid.
And whereas the Constitution of this State provides that in case
of the resignation of a Senator during the Legislative recess a warrant
of election shall be issued by the Governor for the election of another
person in his place

Now therefore I J Watkins Liegou Governor of
Maryland do by virtue of authority in me vested by the Constitution
of the State of Maryland hereby Order and direct that an election for
Senator of the State aforesaid for Worcester County be held at the
places designated by law on the day of the next ensuing election for
Delegates to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of the said
Helleny R Pitts, and that you the Sheriff of Worcester County do give
notice thereof at least ten days exclusive of the day of the publication
of the notice and of the day of election, for all which this shall be
your sufficient warrant.
