Whereas, I have received from the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City, and the Clerks of the several Circuit Courts of this State, certified returns of an Election held on Wednesday the Fourth day of November, eighteen hundred and fifty seven for Members to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, and have carefully ascertained the number of votes given for every person voted for as such,

Now therefore, In pursuance of the law in such case made and provided, I do by this my Proclamation declare, that James F Stewart of the First District, James B Ricard of the Second District, Morrison Harris of the Third District, H Winter Davis of the Fourth District, Jacob W Kunkel of the Fifth District, and Thomas F Davis of the Sixth District, appear by the said Returns to have received the highest number of votes in their respective Districts, and to have been duly elected members to represent this State in the Congress of the United States.
