September 18.

The Governor ordered notice to be given of application for the pardon of Augustus Ford, convicted at the October Term, 1860, of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county; and sentenced to be confined in the Penitentiary for the period of ten years.

On the same day, the Governor pardoned Thomas Locay, or Lokey, convicted at March Term, 1861, of the Circuit Court for Caroline county, of Larceny, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for the period of two years and four months.

September 20.

The Governor remitted the fine of fifty dollars imposed upon William S. Whitely, by the Circuit Court for Caroline County, at October Term, 1860; for selling liquor without license.

On the same day the Governor pardoned Joseph H. Edwards, convicted at October Term, 1860, of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, of Manslaughter, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for the period of five years.
