October 16.

The Governor ordered notice to be given of application for the Pardon of Charles Coulson convicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore, at January Term, 1857, and sentenced to the Penitentiary until the 23rd day of June 1862.

On the same day, the Governor ordered notice to be given of application for the Pardon of William Chrismond, convicted in the Circuit Court for Prince George's county, at April Term, 1861, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for the period of one year and one month.

October 18.

The Governor remitted the fine of twenty-five dollars imposed upon William H. Loona by the Circuit Court for Washington county, at March Term, 1861, for selling goods by sample.

October 22.

The Governor issued a Warrant to the Sheriff of Allegany county, ordering and directing the holding of an election in said county, for a Senator of the State for said county, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Hon. Thomas McKaig.

October 26

The Governor granted a Nolle Prosequi to John Devalin, charged by the Grand Jury of Baltimore city with the crime of manslaughter
