November 22.

The Governor remitted the fine of One Hundred dollars (to the extent of Eighty dollars of the interest of the State therein) which was imposed upon Richard Thomas by the Circuit Court for Charles county, at May Term, 1860, for Assault and Battery.

November 23.

The Governor pardoned Augustus Ford, convicted of Manslaughter, in the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, at October Term, 1860, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for the term of ten years.

On the same day the Governor appointed Louis Gootee Keeper of the House of Delegates, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of Thomas Gardiner.

November 25.

The Governor ordered notice to be given of the application for the pardon of Edward Sutliff, convicted in the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's county at November Term, 1861, and sentenced to six months imprisonment in the county jail.

On the same day, the Governor ordered notice to be given of application for the pardon of Levi Hoffman, convicted in the Criminal Court for Baltimore, at January Term, 1861, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for the term of three years.

November 26.

The Governor ordered notice to be given of the application for the pardon of Frederick Biddison, alias Biddiker, convicted in the Criminal Court for Baltimore, at September Term, 1857, and sentenced to the Penitentiary until the 4th of July, 1870.
