On the same day, the Governor pardoned Levi Hoffman, convicted of Larceny, in the Criminal Court of Baltimore, at January term, 1861, and sentenced to the Penitentiary for three years

The Governor pardoned Frederick Biddison alias Biddiker, convicted in the Criminal Court for Baltimore, at September term, 1861, of murder in the second degree, and sentenced to the Penitentiary until July 4, 1873.
