April 10th

The Governor approved the official Bond of Leander Warren Notary Public of Baltimore City and directed his Commission to issue. Issued accordingly see Record of Executive appointments page 7.

Same day the Governor issued a commission to Robert B. Ballard as Judge of the Orphans Court of Somerset County for the unexpired term of George J. Leadbury removed from the County.

April 12th

The Governor authorized J. L. McPhail Deputy Provost Marshall to take possession of and transmit to the State Armory at Annapolis all the arms and accoutrements heretofore seized by the police authorities in Baltimore and now stored at the station houses and other places in said City.

Same day the Governor issued his requisition upon the Governor of Massachusetts for the rendition of Margaret Murphy charged upon indictment in the Criminal Court of Baltimore City with receiving monies knowing the same to have been stolen. See Record of Pardons page 340.

Same day the Governor issued sundry Military Commissions to Officers of 2nd Maryland Regiment of Volunteers - See Record of Military Commissions Page 3. Also said Commission to John Saunders N.Y.

April 17th

The Governor approved the official Bond of Samuel D. Walker Assistant Inspector of Flour.

Same day the Governor issued commissions to sundry officers of the 2nd Regiment of Maryland Volunteer Infantry. See Military record page 3.

Same day the Governor issued his warrant for the admission of Henry C. Wentz a Deaf Mute into the Columbia Institution under the provisions of Art 33 sections 1 and two of the Code of Public general laws. See Deaf & Dumb record.

Same day the Governor approved the official Bond of Henry Doyle Notary Public and directed his commission to issue. Issued accordingly. See Record of Executive appointments Frederick County.

April 18th

The Governor remitted fine of \$50 imposed on Stanley Coffey for selling Liquor without a License upon condition of payment of costs. See Docket of Pardons No 27.
