 regards to us belonging For we hereby Command our Sheriff of our
 County afo that at Certain days and places which you or three of you (of whom
 any one of you of you the afo William Loch, Josias Towgood or Charles
 Hammond we will to be one) shall make known to him the Cause to come
 before you or three of you (of whom any one of you the said Josias
 Towgood or Charles Hammond we will to be one) such as many
 good and Lawfull men of his bailiwick as well within the Liberties as
 without by which the Truth of the Matter may be better known as
 Inquired into And we do hereby constitute Ordain and Appoint
 the Clerk of the City of Annapolis to be your Clerk to make due Entry
 of all your proceedings therein and to act and do in all things relating
 to the promises as any other Clerk of such Court hath or ought to do in
 the accustomed Benefits and profits thereof And further we do Appoint
 Moses Adney of Ann: County to be your Crier for this Occasion empowering
 him to have and receive the same fees profits and perquisites as any
 other Crier for the like Service heretofore hath had In Testimony
