By Order of the Governor and Council on the 26th Day of Jan^{ry} 1761
Deodimus Potestatem's issued to the several Counties within
this Province directed to the second Third and fourth in the Comms
of the Peace (not being of the Council) in the respective Counties im-
powering them or any two or one of them to administer the Oaths to be
taken to his present Majesty King George the Third to the Chief
Justice of the respective Courts as likewise empowering the said Chief
Justice to swear the above mentioned Three persons Viz: the second Third
and fourth persons (not being of the Council) and also empowering the
Chief Justice, and the other Justices that shall have been sworn by him
or any of them to administer the Oaths to be taken to his present
Majesty King George the Third to all other Officers both Civil and
Military that should apply to take the Oaths in the several
Counties.

15 April By same Order Dead warrant issued to the Sheriff of Baltimore
County for the Execution of Charles Sutton late of Baltimore County Labourer
on Wednesday the twenty ninth instant.
