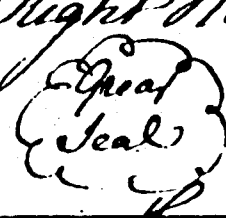


and them to imprison, and cause to be imprisoned in any of the Prisons within
 the Province of Maryland or the maritime Places thereto belonging, and
 such Persons so imprisoned who ought to be delivered therefrom, to command
 and cause to be delivered, and altogether to be acquitted and discharged, and do
 hereby grant unto You Power and Authority of promulgating or interposing all
 Decrees and Sentences whatsoever, and them to command to be executed
 together with the Cognizance and Jurisdiction of all other Lawes (Civil & maritime)
 commenced or to be commenced or which any Way concern or relate to the Sea
 Affairs, or the transporting or Passage over the Sea, or any Naval Journey or
 Maritime Voyage or Maritime Jurisdiction or, also with Power of proceeding
 therein according to the Civil and Maritime Law and Customs of the
 high Court of Admiralty of Great Britain of old used, as well of mere Office
 must or promoted, as at the Instance of any Party as the Case shall require, &
 it shall seem expedient; and do grant you full Authority to execute all singular
 the Premises in the Places of expressed, and do hereby appoint You the said
 Daniel Dulany to be my Comissary in the said Province & Territories of
 during Pleasure HEREBY granting to You the said Daniel Dulany all
 fees Profits and Advantages to the said Office any way belonging, and do
 hereby command all Justices of Peace Mayors Sheriffs Keepers of Goals
 and other Officers and Ministers within this Province to be aiding & assisting
 to You as becometh, as they will answer the contrary at their Peil GIVEN
 at the City of Annapolis the 22. Day of May in the twentieth Year
 of the Dominion of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary
