In Pursuance of an Act of Parliament made & passed in the seventh and eighth Years of the Reign of King William the third Entituled an Act for preventing Frauds and regulating Abuses in the Plantation Trade

I Mr. Patrick Creagh of Maryland Painter that the Schooner Elizabeth of Maryland whereof John Soare is at present Master being a round Sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about Twenty Tons was built in New England in the Year 1729 and called the Mary as appears by a former Register now cancelled and was by Decree of the Court of Vice Admiralty of this Province the 4th Day of November 1734 condemned & forfeited to the Use of his Majesty, his Excellency Samuel Ogle Esq. Governor of the said, and Benjamin Tasker Esq. Surveyor of the Port of Annapolis for the Breach of the Acts of Trade & Navigation, and that he this Deponent is at present Owner thereof; and that no foreigner directly or indirectly hath any Share or Part or Interest therein
