In Pursuance of an Act of Parliament made and passed in the seventh and eighth Years of the Reign of King William the third Intituled an Act for preventing Frauds & regulating Abuses in the Plantation Trade

It is at James Donaldson of Maryland Merchant that the Ship the Ogle of Maryland whereof John Smart is at present Master being a square sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about eighty Tons was built at Boston in the Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England in the Year 1733 and called the Success as appears by a former Register now cancelled and was by Decree of the Court of Vice Admiralty of this Province the 3. Day of March 1734 condemned & forfeited to the Use of his Majesty his Excellency Samuel Ogle Esq. Governor of the said Province and Edward Chambers Esq. Collector of his Majesty's Custom in the District of Tocoman in Breach of the Acts of Trade and Navigation and that he this Defendant is at present Owner thereof and that No foreigner directly or indirectly hath any Share or Part or Interest therein
