Commission renewed to Mr. Joseph Macclister to be high Sheriff of Somerset County

Province of Maryland 1st August 1735

Sam. Ogle (Seal) In pursuance of an Act of Parliament made and passed in the Seventh and eighth years of the Reign of King William the Third Entituled an Act for preventing Frauds and regulating Abuses in the Plantation Trade

That Charles Brown of Maryland Merchant that the Schoop the whim of Maryland whereof Wm. Husband is at present Master being a square Sterned Vessel of the Burthen of about thirty Tons was built at Free Town in New England in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred twenty and nine & called the Sarah as appears by a former Register now delivered up and Cancelled and that Michael Cutler and he this Depon^t are at present Owners thereof and that no Foreigner directly or indirectly hath any Part or Share or Interest therein

28th August 1735

Commission renewed to Mr. Richard Lee to be high Sheriff of Prince Georges County

9th Septem^r 1735

Induction granted in Common form to the Reverend Mr. George William Forester to be Rector of Shrewsbury Parish in Kent County

16th Septem^r 1735

Commission issued in Common form to Mr. Peter Dent to be Deputy Surveyor of Prince Georges County
