Have made Constituted Ordained Authorized and Appointed And by these Presents We do make constitute Ordain Authorize & Appoint him the said Daniel Dulany to be our Chief Agent Escheator and Receiver General of all our Rent Arrears of Rents Fines Forfeitures Tobaccos or Money for Land Warrants of all Ferry Waives Strays & Dead and of all Duties arising from or Growing due upon Exportation of Goods or Tonnage of Ships, and all other Monies Tobaccos or other Effects in any manner or way now due or hereafter to grow due Whither by protest Bills of Exchange or otherwise to us within the said Province hereby Granting to the D. Daniel Dulany full power and Authority to sell & dispose of all Lands Tenements & Hereditaments to us now Escheated or forfeited or hereafter to be Escheated or forfeited to such person or persons as shall agree or pay for them such Reasonable Rates in Money as shall be agreed for Also to Inspect into Order Manage and Account for all & every other Branch & Branches of our Revenue within our said Province Whither the same be or grow due by particular Contract Conditions of Plantation Act or Acts of Assembly or by virtue of our Royalties Rights Privileges and Prerogatives within the said Province And
