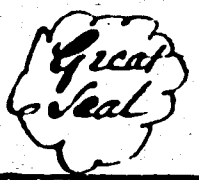


all and every such Person or Persons that shall conceive themselves aggrieved by any definitive Sentence of you or either of you given or to be given their Lawful Rights of Appealing to us or our Governour or Commander in Chief of this Province for the Time being or to such other Person or Persons as we or they shall appoint to hear and determine the same To Have hold Exercise Execute & Enjoy the said Office of Judges and Commissary General and Commissioner in Chief for Probate of Wills and Granting Administrations within our said Province as aforesaid unto you the said Benjamin Tasker and Daniel Dulany by your selves or any ^{one} of you jointly and severally as you shall see Convenient and to take and receive to your proper Uses and behoofs all due and just Fees profits & Emoluments belonging to a Judge of such a Court (to be Equally divided Between you) which have been by us established Or which shall hereafter be by us or our Governour & Council by our Authority hereafter established and generally to Act do perform and Execute all singular the Powers and Jurisdictions to you or either of you hereby Granted until such time as we shall signify our Will & pleasure to the contrary Witness our Trusty and well Beloved Samuel Ogle Esq Governour and Commander in Chief in and Over our said Province at the City of Annapolis this fifth day of February in the Nineteenth year of our Dominion Annoq Domini 1733
