within the Bounds of our said Mannor and also to receive from each &
every of our Tenants on the said Mannor such Rent or Rents as now are
or hereafter shall be due from him her or them to us, you the said Tho.
Muir rendering unto our Chancellor & agent a just & true account & satis-
faction for such Rents as you the said Tho. Muir shall so Receive
as aforesaid yearly & every year and we do hereby further empower and
authorize you the said Tho. Muir to do & execute & perform all & whatso-
ever shall be directed & ordered by any Instructions to be hereafter
at any Time given to you the said Tho. Muir by our Chancellor &
agent for the Time being concerning our said Mannor. Witness
our Trusty & well beloved Samuel Ogle Esq. Governour of our said
Province at the City of Annapolis this twenty seventh day of No-
vember in the twenty first Year of his Lordships Dominion &c.
