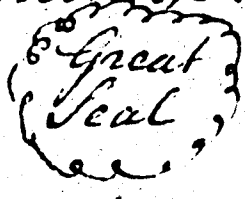

Mail & John Akin of our special Grace have pardoned & remitted
& by these Presents for us our Heirs & Successors do pardon Remit
& Release to the said John Mail & John Akin by whatsoever Name in name
or addition or Designation they may be known & esteemed all further
Imprisonment & Restraint for the Cause aforesaid And we do by these Presents
chiefly Charge & Command our Sheriff of the said County them the said John
Mail & John Akin from all Restraint & Imprisonment for the Cause
aforesaid only forthwith to release & discharge In Testimony whereof we
have caused these our Letters to be made Patent Witness our
Trusty & well beloved Samuel Oyle Esq^r Governour of our said
Province this twenty second day of November in the twenty first year of
his Lordship's Dominion &c. Annoq^{ue} Domini 1735
