 the said Province send Greeting

Whereas you have Represented to me that your pressing  
 and Urgent private Affairs require your immediate Presence in  
 Great Britain and Absence from the duty of your Parish for a  
 Reasonable time and that you have provided your said Parish  
 with a Minister of the Church of England as by Law Established  
 of Good Life and Conversation to perform divine Service in your  
 said Parish and to take care that the Souls of your said Parish  
 be in no wise neglected during your Absence And Whereas I have  
 and do fully approve of the said Minister you have so Provided, I there-  
 fore for the reasons aforesaid do hereby as far as in me lies Grant  
 unto you Special Leave and Liberty to Absent your self from your  
 said Parish and Cure thereof for and during the space and term of  
 One whole Year from the Date hereof and to Receive the Profits of  
 your said Parish Rectorship and Incumbency during such time as  
 as full manner as if you was personally present and Resident in  
 the said Parish and Cure thereof Given at the City of Annapolis this  
 15<sup>th</sup> Day of August Anno Domini 1738
