Receive for you all such just fees, perquisites and  
Advantages as shall be or hereafter by Law allowed To  
survive and to hold the said Office of Examiner General  
during our good will and pleasure Witness Our trusty  
and Well Beloved Samuel Ogle Esq Governor and Commans-  
der in chief in and over our said Province this 29 day of  
September in the 2<sup>d</sup> Year of our Dominion Annoq Dni 1738
